EICs: Dennis Galletta and Paul Benjamin Lowry
(annual data: As of December 1, 2018)

Acceptance rate (excluding special issues)	38.97%
Average time: submission to first decision	65
Average time: submission to final acceptance	171

AIS Transactions in HCI (THCI)

- “We are always interested in senior people proposing interesting and original special issues, as that does our journal a lot of good. We could also use more leading piecing that involve theory building and research commentaries, especially from experienced HCI researchers or teams involving them. ” - THCI EIC
- Impact Factor
 - Rejected: ISI Web of Science (takes 6 years, at least 4 papers each issue)
 - Many issues only had two articles
 - Alternatives: SCOPUS
 - Working on completing outstanding requests regarding information content on the website and supplying information to SCOPUS regarding the review process and key metrics
- Consider submitting your best work

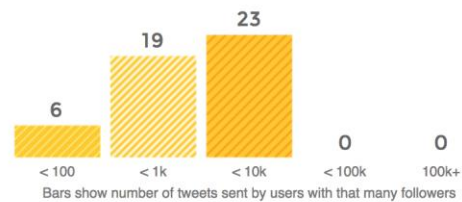

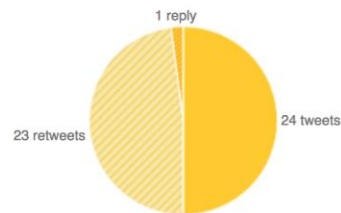
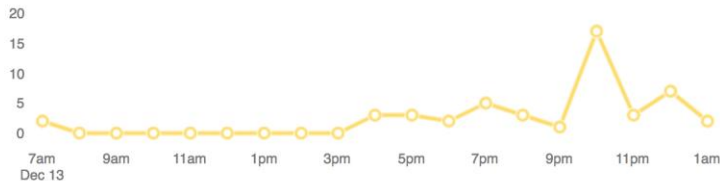
